## HISTORY

The Moonlight Markets have been running biennually since 1998 and have made a very successful name for themselves in our community.

Typically the markets raise over \$20k for our school!

Funds raised (combined with grants) over the years have upgraded the facilities of the Moonlight Hall (enclosing this area, painting, stage, sound system and 5 split system air-conditioners), the new playground in the Kindy/Pre-Primary area, the undercover area where the children eat their recess and lunch, ongoing work on the Nature Play Area, Teachers wish lists and so much more.

In 2007, the Falls Road P&C were awarded the inaugural Australian Women's Weekly P&C winner for the state of WA, largely due to the success of these Markets. The \$2K prize money was spent on the large screen in the front office which displays photos of the children.
