Tip 3: Help them to relax – provide them with some relaxation strategies, e.g. take 3 deep breaths, have a drink of water, re-read the questions.

Tip 4: Prepare – have a good night's sleep and a good breakfast.

Tip 5: Encourage them to have a go, focus on doing their best and the results will take care of themselves.
